AN ORDINANCE to amend the Sugar Industry Special Funds Ordinance Ch. 23. No. 14

**[On Proclamation]**

*Commencement.*

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof. Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Sugar Industry Special Funds (Amendment) Ordinance, 1961 and shall be read as one with the Sugar Industry Special Funds Ordinance hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Short title.

2. Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and replaced by the following section—

“Committees  
to manage  
the special  
funds.

8. (1) The Sugar Industry Price Stabilization Fund shall be controlled and administered by a Committee appointed by the Governor in Council and consisting of—

- (a) three persons nominated by the Sugar Manufacturers Association of Trinidad (Incorporated);
- (b) two persons nominated by the Trinidad Island Wide Cane-Farmers Association; and
- (c) two public officers.

(2) The Sugar Industry Rehabilitation Fund shall be controlled and administered by—

- (a) a Committee appointed by the Governor in Council and consisting of—
  - (i) four persons nominated by the Sugar Manufacturers Association of Trinidad (Incorporated);
  - (ii) two persons nominated by the Trinidad Island Wide Cane-Farmers Association; and
  - (iii) two public officers; and

(b) the Cane-Farmers Rehabilitation Board established under the Cane-Farmers Rehabilitation Board Ordinance, 1961, in such proportions as the Governor in Council may from time to time direct by order, but the proportion to be controlled and administered by the Committee shall be not less than eighty per cent. in any year.

(3) The Sugar Industry Labour Welfare Fund shall be controlled and administered by a Committee appointed by the Governor in Council and consisting of—

- (a) three persons nominated by the Sugar Manufacturers Association of Trinidad (Incorporated);
- (b) two persons nominated by the Trinidad Island Wide Cane-Farmers Association;
- (c) three persons nominated by the Trade Unions concerned with the welfare of labour workers in the sugar industry; and
- (d) two public officers.”

3. This Ordinance shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Governor by proclamation published in the *Royal Gazette*. Commencement

Passed in Council this second day of June, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-one.
