**Act No. 40 of 1970**

AN ACT to make miscellaneous amendments to the  
Ordinances relating to the Sugar Industry.

*[Assented to 4th November, 1970]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment.  
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and  
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by  
the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Sugar Industry Enact- Short title.  
ments (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act, 1970.

Construction  
of references.

2. (1) A reference in any of the enactments to which this Act applies or in any instrument made under any of those enactments to the Sugar Manufacturers' Association of Trinidad (Incorporated) (however worded and whether express or implied) shall, from the 15th December, 1968, be construed as a reference to SMA Limited or its successors and any sugar manufacturer who is not a member thereof.

(2) This Act applies to the following enactments—

(a) the Sugar Industry Special Funds Ordinance;

No. 19 of 1961.

(b) the Cane Farmers' Rehabilitation Board Ordinance;

No. 32 of 1961.

(c) the Agricultural Small Holdings Tenure Ordinance; and

No. 14 of 1966.

(d) the Sugar Industry Control Board Act, 1966.

Power to  
appoint  
committees, &c.  
in Minister  
instead of  
Governor-  
General.

3. Where the Governor-General is, by any of the enactments to which this Act applies, empowered to appoint as members of any Boards, Committees, Tribunals or other such bodies, persons nominated by the Sugar Manufacturers' Association of Trinidad Limited, the reference to the Governor-General, in any such enactment shall be read as a reference to the Minister to whom responsibility for the subject of Agriculture is assigned.

Validation.

4. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary it is hereby declared that between 15th December, 1968, and the commencement of this Act, all Boards, Committees, Tribunals and other bodies referred to in section 3 were validly constituted and any act or thing done or omitted during that period by any such Board, Committee, Tribunal or other body in pursuance of the provisions of any enactment to which this Act applies is hereby deemed to be validly and properly done or omitted.
