AN ACT to amend the Sugar Industry Special Funds  
Ordinance, Ch. 23. No. 14.

*[Assented to 6th January, 1971]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, <sup>Enactment.</sup>  
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and  
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and  
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Sugar Industry Special <sup>Short title.</sup>  
Funds (Amendment) Act, 1970.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Sugar Industry (Labour Welfare Fund) Regulations, 1952-1953, two million, five hundred thousand dollars of the moneys standing to the credit of the Sugar Industry Labour Welfare Fund as at 30th September, 1970, shall be credited to the Sugar Industry Price Stabilisation Fund and used in accordance with the Sugar Industry Price Stabilisation Fund Regulations, 1961.
