AN ACT to amend the Statutes Act, 1962.

[Assented to 18th June, 1976]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment}
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Statutes (Amendment) ^{Short title}
Act, 1976.

2. The Statutes Act, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") is amended by substituting the word "Assent" for the words "Royal Assent" wherever they occur in the Act.

3. Section 3 of the Act is repealed and replaced as follows :—

"Enacting
and other
clauses

3. (1) The words of enactment shall follow the preamble, if any, and the various clauses within the purview or body of the statute shall follow in a concise and enunciative form.

(2) In every Bill presented to the President for assent, other than a Bill passed under section 64 or 65 of the Constitution of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago, the words of enactment shall be as follows—

"Enacted by the Parliament of
Trinidad and Tobago as
follows—".

(3) In every Bill passed under section 64 or 65 of the Constitution and presented to the President for assent, the words of enactment shall be as follows—

"Enacted by the President by and
with the advice and consent
of the House of Representa-
tives in accordance with the
provisions of section 64 or 65
of the Constitution and by the
authority of the same as
follows—" "
