AN ORDINANCE to amend the Trade Unions Ordinance.

[30th December, 1943.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Trade Unions Short title
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1943, and shall be read as one Ch. 22, No. 8.
with the Trade Unions Ordinance hereinafter referred to
as the Principal Ordinance.

Section 16 of
Principal
Ordinance
amended.

2. Section 16 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by:—

- (a) adding at the end of subsection (1) thereof immediately after the word "registrar" the words "and the trade union shall pay such person or persons in accordance with the scale of fees prescribed by regulations made under this Ordinance";
- (b) adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered (4)—

"(4) The registrar may at any time order the books, accounts, vouchers, documents, securities and funds of any trade union to be inspected or audited by some fit and proper person or persons appointed by him, and it shall be the duty of the secretary, treasurer and other officers of a trade union to make available to the person or persons so appointed all the accounts, books, documents, vouchers, securities and funds of the trade union for purposes of inspection or audit.

The registrar shall pay the person or persons appointed by him under the provisions of this subsection—

- (a) in the case of an inspection, such fees as he may deem reasonable;
- (b) in the case of an audit, in accordance with the scale of fees prescribed by regulations made under this Ordinance".

Section 18 of
Principal
Ordinance
amended.

3. Subsection (2) of section 18 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended:—

- (a) by deleting the word "and" at the end of paragraph (e) thereof;
- (b) by substituting the following for paragraph (f) thereof—

"(f) a scale of fees to be paid to the proper person or persons appointed by the registrar to audit the accounts, books, documents, vouchers, securities and funds of a trade union;

(g) generally, for carrying out this Ordinance into effect."
