AN ORDINANCE to amend the Theatres and Dance
Halls Ordinance, 1934.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Theatres and Short title.
Dance Halls (Amendment) Ordinance, 1935.

2. Section 7 of the Theatres and Dance Halls Amendment
Ordinance, 1934, is hereby amended by deleting the words of s. 7 of
"to any cinema licensed under the provisions of the No. 39-1934.
Cinematograph Ordinance, or" in the 4th and 5th lines
of the said section.
