

LEGAL NOTICE No. 80

REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, CHAP. 35:01

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 5(2) of the Town and Country Planning Act, Chap. 35:01 that no later than seven years after the commencement of the Act or within such extended period as Parliament may by resolution allow, the Minister shall submit for the approval of Parliament a development plan consisting of a report of the survey together with a plan indicating the manner in which he proposes that land in Trinidad and Tobago may be used (whether by the carrying out of development or otherwise) and the stages by which any such development may be carried out:

And whereas Parliament by various resolutions allowed that the period for the submission of a development plan by the Minister be extended to 29th October, 1981:

And whereas a development plan was not submitted for the approval of Parliament by 29th October, 1981:

And whereas it is now necessary and expedient that the period within which a development plan be submitted by the Minister for the approval of Parliament be further extended:

Be it resolved:

That the period for the submission of a development plan by the Minister for the approval of Parliament be extended to 31st May, 1984.
