

LEGAL NOTICE No. 122

REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, CHAP. 35:01

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 5(2) of the Town and Country Planning Act, Chap. 35:01 that no later than seven years after the commencement of the Act, or, within such extended period as Parliament may by resolution allow, the Minister shall submit for the approval of Parliament a development plan consisting of a report of the survey together with a plan indicating the manner in which he proposes that land in Trinidad and Tobago may be used (whether by the carrying out of development or otherwise) and the stages by which any such development may be carried out:

And whereas Parliament by various resolutions from time to time allowed that the period for the submission of a development plan by the Minister be extended to 31st May, 1984:

And whereas in conformity with this extension the Minister submitted for approval to the Senate on 15th May, 1984 and to the House of Representatives on 18th May, 1984, a development plan called The National Physical Development Plan—Trinidad and Tobago: Volumes I and II:

And whereas it is expedient that the development plan be approved by Parliament:

*Be it resolved:*

That the development plan called the National Physical Development Plan—Trinidad and Tobago: Volumes I and II, be approved.
