AN ORDINANCE to amend the Patents, Designs and Trade Marks Ordinance, No. 76.

[19th November, 1918.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short Title.      1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Patents, Designs and Trade Marks (Amendment) Ordinance, 1918.

2. After the word "Registrar" in the second paragraph of Section 59 of the Patents, Designs and Trade Marks Ordinance (No. 76) shall be read the words "save and except the fee of 10/- for publication in the *Royal Gazette*, which shall be paid to the Manager of the Government Printing Office."
