AN ORDINANCE to amend the Stamp Duty Ordinance, 1908.

[1st January, 1925.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Stamp Duty (Amendment) Ordinance, 1924, and shall be read as one with the Stamp Duty Ordinance, 1908, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance. Short title. Construction. (28-1908)

2. Section 14 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion of the words "or the Postmaster-General" after the words "Receiver-General" in the third and fourth lines thereof. Amendment of s. 14 of Principal Ordinance.
