AN ORDINANCE to amend the Stamp Duty Ordinance.

[1st January, 1929.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Stamp Duty Short title. (Amendment) Ordinance, 1928, and shall be read as one Construction with the Stamp Duty Ordinance, hereinafter called the Cap. 206. Principal Ordinance.
2. On and after the first day of January, 1929, the Duty on stamp duty on a receipt given for or upon the payment of of cheques and receipts.

money amounting to £2 or upwards and on a cheque shall be one penny, and the Schedule to the Principal Ordinance shall be deemed to be amended accordingly.
