AN ORDINANCE to amend the Stamp Duty Ordinance,
Cap. 206.

[16th April, 1932.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council, thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Stamp Duty (Amendment) Ordinance, 1932, and shall be read and construed as one with the Stamp Duty Ordinance, Cap. 206, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Short title.
Construction.

2. The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion therein under the heading "General exemptions from all Stamp Duties" of the following:—

Debentures issued in the Colony by the Government, and instruments for sale or transfer of such debentures.
