AN ORDINANCE to restrict the slaughtering of cattle.

*[18<sup>th</sup> March, 1921.]*

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Slaughter of Short title. cattle (restriction) Ordinance, 1921.

2. Every person who slaughters or causes to be slaughtered any heifer under the age of two years shall be guilty of an Heifers under 2 years of age not to be offence punishable on summary conviction before a slaughtered. magistrate and on conviction shall be liable to a fine not exceeding twenty-five pounds.

This section shall not apply to any animal slaughtered Proviso. in obedience to lawful authority or from a humanitarian motive such as the prevention of suffering or because of disease or for any other sufficient cause.
