AN ORDINANCE to amend the Summary Offences Ordinance, Ch. 4. No. 17.

**E**NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

**1.** This Ordinance may be cited as the Summary Offences (Amendment) Ordinance, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Summary Offences Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the word "twelve" for the word "six". Section 6 of Principal Ordinance amended.
3. Sections 50 and 51 of the Principal Ordinance are hereby respectively amended by substituting the words "may be deemed" for the words "shall be deemed". Sections 50 and 51 of Principal Ordinance amended.
4. Section 75 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the words "two hundred and forty" and "six months" for the words "twenty-four" and "one month" respectively. Section 75 of Principal Ordinance amended.
