**Act No. 18 of 1970**

AN ACT to amend the provisions of the Summary Offences  
Ordinance relating to Larceny of Livestock.

*[Assented to 16th June, 1970]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, <sup>Enactment.</sup>  
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and  
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and  
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Summary Offences <sup>Short title.</sup>  
(Amendment) Act, 1970.

2. Section 28 of the Summary Offences Ordinance is amended as follows:—

- (a) by deleting the words “or any bull, cow, ox, heifer, or calf or any ram, ewe, sheep, lamb or goat or swine” occurring therein; and
- (b) by deleting the words “such cattle” occurring in line 7 thereof and substitute therefor the words “such animal”.
