AN ORDINANCE to amend the Summary Courts  
Ordinance, Ch. 3. No. 4.

[3rd June, 1943.]

Commencement.

**E**NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Summary Courts Short Title.  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1943, and shall be read as one Construction.  
with the Summary Courts Ordinance, hereinafter referred to Ch. 3. No. 4.  
as the Principal Ordinance.

Section 136 of  
the Principal  
Ordinance  
amended.

2. Section 136 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by re-numbering the same as 136 (1) and by adding the following subsection thereto as subsection (2) :—

(2) Every notification required by this section to be given by the Clerk shall be in writing signed by him, and may be transmitted—

(a) by ordinary post to the solicitor of the appellant or respondent ; or

(b) by registered post to the appellant at the address appearing on the recognizance entered into by the appellant under the provisions of section 133 ; or

(c) by registered post to the respondent at his last known place of abode,  
and shall be deemed to have been served at the time when any letter so transmitted would be delivered in the ordinary course of the post.
