AN ACT to amend the Narcotic Control Ordinance, 1961
and to make consequential amendments to the
Summary Courts Ordinance, Ch. 3. No. 4.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Narcotic Control Short title
(Amendment) Act, 1976.

Section 5 of
Ordinance No. 27
of 1961 amended

2. Section 5 of the Narcotic Control Ordinance, 1961 is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:—

“Power to
convict
persons for
possession
of narcotic
on trial
for
trafficking

5. Upon the trial of a person who is charged with an offence under section 4(4), if the magistrate or the jury is or are not satisfied that such person is guilty thereof but is or are satisfied that he is guilty of an offence under section 4(1), the magistrate or the jury may find him guilty of such latter offence.”.

3. The Second Schedule to the Summary Courts Ordinance is amended by repealing paragraph 12 and substituting therefor the following:—

“Ordinance
No. 27 of
1961

12. Offences under section 4(4) of the Narcotic Control Ordinance, 1961.”.
