Act No. 2 of 1974

AN ACT to amend the Supreme Court of Judicature Act, 1962.

[Assented to 27th February, 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by ^{Enactment} and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Supreme Court of ^{Short title} Judicature (Amendment) Act, 1974.

2. Section 75 of the Supreme Court of Judicature Act, 1962, is repealed and replaced as follows:—

“Sitting of
Court of
Appeal

75. (1) Subject to subsection (2) the Court of Appeal shall sit in Port-of-Spain at such times as may be prescribed for the hearing and determination of all appeals.

(2) In addition to the sitting of the Court of Appeal in accordance with subsection (1), sittings of the Court of Appeal for the hearing and determination of such classes of appeals as may be prescribed, may be held at San Fernando and Scarborough at such times between the periods prescribed by Order 1, Rule 4 of the Court of Appeal Rules, 1962 as the Chief Justice may direct.”
