An Act to amend the Supreme Court of Judicature Act, 1962.

[Assented to 27th February, 1978]

Enacted by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the Supreme Court of short title Judicature (Amendment) Act, 1978.

- 2. Subsection (1) of section 6 of the Supreme Court of Judicature Act, 1962, is repealed and the following is substituted therefor:—
 - "(1) The Judges of the Court of Appeal shall be the Chief Justice who shall be President and five other Justices of Appeal; the court, however, shall be deemed to be duly constituted during and notwithstanding any vacancy in the office of any Judge.".
- **3.** Section 6 of the Supreme Court of Judicature Act, 1962 is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (2) thereof the following

"(2A) The Court may, if the Chief Justice so directs, sit in two divisions at the same time.".
