AN ORDINANCE to amend the Registration
Ordinance No. 56.

[1st January, 1919.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in Sections 35, 45 and 47 of the Registration Ordinance (No. 56) Superintendent Registrars who hold office as such by virtue of their appointment as Wardens shall not be entitled to retain for their own use the fees referred to in the said sections, but shall pay all such fees into the Treasury for the use of the Colony.

2. This Ordinance shall commence on the first day of January, 1919.
