ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1)
OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(SIPARIA KI MAI CELEBRATIONS) ORDER, 1994

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Siparia Ki Mai Celebrations) Order, 1994.

2. This Order has effect between the hours of 3.00 p.m. on Thursday, 31st March, 1994 and 12.00 noon on Friday, 1st April, 1994.

3. Vehicular traffic is prohibited on the following roads:

Roads closed

- (a) George Street, between Edward Street and La Pastora Street;
- (b) Mary Street, between Edward Street and La Pastora Street;
- (c) La Pastora Street, between Victoria Street and Siparia-Erin Road;
- (d) De Gannes Lane;
- (e) Victoria Street, between Coora Road and La Pastora Street;
- (f) Siparia Old Road, between Potters Lane and Siparia-Erin Road;
- (g) Siparia-Erin Road, between La Pastora Street and Logie Street;
- (h) Mary Street, between Station Street and Coora Road;
- (i) La Pastora Street.

4. (1) Motorists approaching Siparia from Erin along Siparia-Erin Road and proceeding towards San Fernando, shall turn North into Siparia Old Road, East into Gambal Street, continuing East into Grell Street and then East into Siparia-Erin Road.

Traffic routes

(2) Motorists approaching Siparia from Fyzabad along the Siparia Old Road, shall turn East into Gambal Street, continuing East into Grell Street and then East into Siparia-Erin Road.

5. Motorists shall proceed in a westerly direction only on Siparia-Erin Road, between Edward Street and La Pastora Street.

6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
