MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO THIRTY-SECOND
ANNIVERSARY OF INDEPENDENCE CELEBRATIONS
(TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) ORDER, 1994

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago Thirty-Second Anniversary of Independence Celebrations (Temporary Provisions) Order, 1994.

Duration

2. This Order has effect between 6.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon on Wednesday, 31st August, 1994.

Parking
prohibited

3. (1) Subject to subparagraph (2), no person may park or cause or permit any vehicle to be parked as follows:

(a) from 6.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m. on—

- (i) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Cipriani Boulevard;
- (ii) Chancery Lane, between Keate Street and Queen's Park West;
- (iii) Dere Street;
- (iv) Albion Street;
- (v) Gordon Street;
- (vi) Frederick Street, between Queen's Park West and Park Street;

(b) from 6.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m. on Park Street, between Frederick Street and St. Vincent Street; and

(c) from 6.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon on—

- (i) Western Main Road from its junction with Tragarete Road to its junction with Long Circular Road; and
- (ii) Tragarete Road.

(2) Notwithstanding subparagraph (1) taxi drivers operating their taxis for hire may park their taxis in the taxi stand on the western side of Dere Street.

4. The following roads shall be closed to vehicular traffic during the Roads closed
specified times:

- (a) from 9.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m. on Queen's Park West,
between Queen's Park East and Chancery Lane;
- (b) from 9.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m. on Keate Street, between
Charlotte Street and Abercromby Street;
- (c) from 9.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m. on Frederick Street, between
Queen's Park West and Park Street;
- (d) from 9.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m. on Park Street, between Henry
Street and St. Vincent Street;
- (e) from 9.30 a.m. to 12.00 noon on Tragarete Road;
- (f) from 10.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon on Western Main Road,
between Damian Street and Lucknow Street; and
- (g) from 9.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m. on Pembroke Street, between
Keate Street and Gordon Street.

5. Motorists shall enter into Queen's Park Savannah—

Entry into
Savannah

- (a) through the entrance opposite Whitehall, if the vehicle is to
form part of the Independence Anniversary Parade and
belongs to either the Defence Force, the Police Service, the
Fire Service or a voluntary organisation;
- (b) through the entrance opposite Frederick Street, if the
vehicle is being used to transport personnel of the Defence
Force, the Police Service, the Fire Service or a voluntary
organisation.

6. Motorists may, between 6.00 a.m. and 11.00 a.m., park their Parking
vehicles on the Queen's Park Savannah, South of the Grand Stand, as Queen's Park
Savannah
directed by Police Officers on duty.

7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the Removal of
commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in vehicles
contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded unlawfully
parked
and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles
and Road Traffic Act.
