AN ACT to amend the Copyright Ordinance, Ch. 31. No. 16.

[Assented to 13th September, 1966]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Copyright (Amendment) Short title
Act, 1966.

2. The Copyright Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) in section 3 by substituting for the word "Three" occurring in the first line thereof the word "Six";

(b) by substituting for section 4 thereof the following:—

"Disposal
of copies

4. Two of such copies shall be transmitted to the Minister and one to each of the following:

(a) the Government Archivist;

(b) the Librarian of the Central Library, Port-of-Spain;

(c) the Senior Librarian, University of the West Indies, St. Augustine Branch;

(d) the Registrar General."

(c) in section 5, by substituting for the word "three" occurring in the first line, the word "six".
