Act No. 26 of 1973

AN ACT to amend the County Councils Act, 1967.

[Assented to 21st August, 1973]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the County Councils Short title (Amendment) Act, 1973.

2. The County Councils Act, 1967, is amended—

(a) by adding immediately after section 7, the following section:—

“Chairman
of County
Council
to be
Justice of
the Peace

7A. The Chairman of a County Council shall be *ex officio* a Justice of the Peace for the electoral area of the County Council of which he is the Chairman.”;

(b) by adding immediately after paragraph (f) of section 23(3), the following paragraph—

“(g) issue notices or other documents on behalf of a County Council in the exercise of its functions under the Public Health Ordinance.”;

(c) by renumbering paragraph (g) as paragraph (h).
