AN ORDINANCE to amend the Workmen's Compensation
Ordinance, 1926 (No. 8 of 1926).

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Workmen's Short title.

3. The definition of "Workman" in section 2 (1) of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph after paragraph (j) :

(k) persons in the civil employment of His Majesty otherwise than in His Government of the Colony.

4. Section 3 (4) of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "before a Commissioner".

5. Section 17 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by striking out the first paragraph and the words "Provided that" in the first line of the second paragraph and substituting therefor the words "In the application of this Ordinance to persons in the civil employment of His Majesty in His Government of this Colony".

of Schedule to
8-1926.

6. The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) In the first and third items there shall be substituted for the word "right", the word "either";

(b) The second and fifth items shall be deleted.
