AN ORDINANCE to amend the Workmen's Compensation Ordinance, Ch. 22. No. 12.

[25th November, 1948.]

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Workmen's Compensation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Workmen's Compensation Ordinance hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Subsection (1) of section 20 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following section :—

“ 1. The Judges of the Supreme Court shall be Commissioners for Workmen's Compensation for the Colony, and the Magistrate from time to time assigned for duty as such in the Island of Tobago shall, in addition to the Judges of the Supreme Court, be a commissioner for Workmen's Compensation for the Island of Tobago.”

3. Section 21 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed.
