AN ORDINANCE to amend the Droghers
Ordinance, 1914.

[*21st* May, 1921.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Droghers Ordinance, 1921. Short title.

2. In section 18 of the Droghers Ordinance, 1914, Amendment of s. 18 of Ord. 41-1914.
in lieu of the words "Five Pounds" shall be read the words "two pounds."

3. In section 24 of the Droghers Ordinance, 1914, Amendment of s. 24 of Ord. 41-1914.
in lieu of the words "two months" shall be read the words "one month."


