ORDER

MADE BY THE TRANSPORT BOARD UNDER SUBSECTION (8) OF SECTION 44 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE AS ENACTED BY THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1956

THE SPEED LIMITS (BUILT-UP AREAS) ORDER, 1966

1. This Order may be cited as the Speed Limits (Built-up Areas) Order 1966.
2. The portions of the roads specified in the Schedule are hereby declared to be built-up areas for the purposes of section 44 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance. Ch. 16. No. 3.

THE SCHEDULE

1. The Southern Main Road, McBean, 200 yards East of Calcutta Road No. 3 (Deonarine Junction) in the County of Caroni.
2. The Southern Main Road, McBean, 520 yards West of Calcutta Road No. 3 (Deonarine Junction) in the County of Caroni.

MADE BY THE TRANSPORT BOARD UNDER SECTION 44C OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

THE QUEEN'S PARK SAVANNAH PARKING ORDER, 1966

1. This Order may be cited as the Queen's Park Savannah Parking Order, 1966.
2. (1) Subject to paragraph (2) no person shall park or cause or permit any vehicle to be or to remain parked on that side of any of the roads abutting the Queen's Park Savannah which is further away from the said Savannah.
(2) Subparagraph (1) does not apply to that portion of the road designated as Queen's Park West which lies between the eastern entrance and the western entrance of the Princes Building and which is commonly known as the Princes Building Taxi Stand.
- (3) Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of subparagraph (1) is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of one hundred dollars or to imprisonment for three months.

AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES ORDINANCE

THE AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES (MANUFACTURE
OF PRESTRESSED AND POSTSTRESSED CONCRETE
PRODUCTS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1966

1. This Order may be cited as the Aid to Pioneer Industries (Manufacture of Prestressed and Poststressed Concrete Products) (Amendment) Order, 1966.

2. The following paragraph is hereby substituted for paragraph 2 of the Aid to Pioneer Industries (Manufacture of Prestressed and Poststressed Concrete Products) Order, 1958 as amended by the Aid to Pioneer Industries (Manufacture of Prestressed and Poststressed Concrete Products) (Amendment) Order, 1962 and the Aid to Pioneer Industries (Manufacture of Prestressed and Poststressed Concrete Products) (Amendment) Order, 1965 :—

“ 2. The manufacture of prestressed and poststressed concrete products is hereby declared to be a pioneer industry and concrete piles, concrete slabs, concrete beams, concrete pipes, concrete poles, concrete posts, concrete double tees, concrete channels, concrete panels and concrete lintels so manufactured are hereby declared to be the pioneer products of that industry ”.
