Act No. 31 of 1977

AN ACT to provide for Marjorie Joseph (Deceased) former Teacher I, Ministry of Education and Culture, to be regarded as if she had been duly confirmed in her post and for matters connected therewith.

[Assented to 22nd July, 1977]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as **Enactment** follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Marjorie Joseph (Con- **Short title** firmation of Appointment) Act, 1977.

Payment of
gratuity and
arrears of
salary

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary—

- (a) for the purpose of the payment of any gratuity to the legal personal representative of Marjorie Joseph, deceased, a former Teacher I, Ministry of Education and Culture, Marjorie Joseph shall be regarded as if she had been confirmed in such post with effect from 7th September, 1970, and granted the increments which had accrued to her;
- (b) there shall be paid to the legal personal representative of the said Marjorie Joseph the difference between any salary paid to Marjorie Joseph and that which would have been payable to her had she been confirmed in such post with effect from 7th September, 1970, and granted the increments which had accrued to her.
