REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 39 of 1977

[L.S.]

AN ACT to provide for the Incorporation of the Trinidad and Tobago Wrestling Association and for matters incidental thereto.

[Assented to 20th September, 1977]

WHEREAS there has been established in this country an Association known as the "Trinidad and Tobago Wrestling Association";

And whereas it is expedient that the said Association should be incorporated for the purpose of exercising the powers hereinafter set forth:

Enactment

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago, as follows:—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Trinidad and Tobago Wrestling Association (Incorporation) Act, 1977.

Incorporation

2. The Association known as the Trinidad and Tobago Wrestling Association shall be and is hereby created a body corporate and by that name shall have perpetual succession, and may sue and be sued in all courts of justice in the Territory and shall have and use a common seal with power from time to time to change such seal.

Powers of Corporation

3. The corporation hereby created shall have power—

- (a) to make, adopt, establish and enforce any rules and regulations for and concerning the nomination, election, suspension removal and expulsion of any of its officers and members;
- (b) to collect manage and dispose of its property;
- (c) to manage its affairs and of any other matter or thing which concerns the good government of the corporation.
- (d) to promote and hold wrestling cards, rallies and all wrestling sport activities under the rules of Wrestling held under the International Sporting Code, the General Competition Rules and Standing Regulations of the Trinidad and Tobago Wrestling Association or other recognised wrestling authority and in connection therewith to exercise all such powers and to do all such things as are usual or incidental to the holding of such wrestling cards, rallies or other wrestling sport activities;

Saving of
State and
other rights

7. Nothing in this Act shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of The State of Trinidad and Tobago, or of any bodies politic or corporate or of any other persons, except such as are mentioned or referred to in this Act and those claiming by, through, from or under them.
