Act No. 50 of 1977

AN ACT to provide for Jonathan Brown, former Administrative Officer IV, Ministry of Works, to be deemed to have been appointed on promotion to the post of Accounting Executive II in the Ministry of Works with effect from 26th March, 1970 and for matters connected therewith.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Jonathan Brown Short title
(Promotion and Superannuation Benefits) Act, 1977.

Appointment on
promotion and
payment of
gratuity and
pension

2. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of any law relating to appointments in the Public Service, Jonathan Brown, former Administrative Officer IV, Ministry of Works, who retired from the Public Service with effect from the 7th day of January, 1971, is deemed to have been appointed on promotion to the post of Accounting Executive II in that Ministry with effect from the 26th day of March, 1970 and to have retired in that post.

(2) There shall be paid out of the Consolidated Fund to the said Jonathan Brown a gratuity of twenty-six thousand, seven hundred and sixty-six dollars and seventy-five cents and a pension, payable monthly, at the rate of six thousand, four hundred and twenty-four dollars and two cents per annum, so however that, any sums paid before the commencement of this Act to the said Jonathan Brown by way of gratuity and pension shall be set off against the sums to which he is entitled to be paid under this Act.
