Act No. 61 of 1975

An Act to provide for the payment of a gratuity to Alfred Best, a former Estate Constable, in the Ministry of Education and Culture.

[Assented to 18th December, 1975]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Alfred Best (Gratuity) Short title Act, 1975.

Payment of gratuity to Alfred Best authorised 2. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary there shall be paid out of the Consolidated Fund to Alfred Best, in respect of his service as an Estate Constable in the Ministry of Education and Culture, a gratuity in the sum of six hundred and forty-four dollars.
