TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO
Act No. 34 of 1976

AN ACT to provide for the preservation of pension rights of Noel Knollys Inniss, a former Senior Dental Surgeon, Ministry of Health (subsequently employed in the service of the Government of St. Vincent) in respect of his service with the Government of Trinidad and Tobago and for the payment to him of a gratuity and pension in respect of that service.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and

House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Noel Knollys Inniss (Preservation of Pension Rights, Pension and Gratuity) Act, 1976.

Pension rights to be preserved Pension and Gratuity to be paid

2. (1) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, authority is hereby given—

- (a) for the preservation of pension rights of Noel Knollys Inniss in respect of his service with the Government from 1st April, 1946 to 6th April, 1966; and
- (b) for the payment to him out of the Consolidated Fund of a gratuity of twelve thousand one hundred and fifty dollars and a reduced pension payable monthly at the rate of two thousand nine hundred and sixteen dollars per annum on his retirement from the public service in pensionable circumstances.

(2) In this section “public service” includes service with the Government of St. Vincent.
