AN ACT to amend the Trade Ordinance, 1958.

[Assented to 14th June, 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House
of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the
authority of the same as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Trade (Amendment) Short title
Act, 1974.

2. Section 2 of the Trade Ordinance, 1958, is amended by substituting for the definition of "goods" appearing therein, the following :—

“‘goods’ includes all kinds of goods, produce, wares, merchandise, substances and animals, but does not include petroleum products as defined by section 2 of the Petroleum Act, 1969;”.

3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of February, 1974.
