Act No. 1 of 1975

AN ACT to provide for the payment of a gratuity and a reduced pension to Edith Lacey and Evelyn Robinson-Nottingham formerly Temporary Ward Assistants (later redesignated Nurses' Aides) in the Ministry of Health.

[Assented to 27th March, 1975]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House

of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Lacey and Robinson-Nottingham (Gratuity and Pensions) Act, 1974.

Authority to pay gratuity and pension to Edith Lacey and Evelyn Robinson-Nottingham

2. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary there shall be paid out of the Consolidated Fund—

- (a) to Edith Lacey in respect of her service as a Temporary Ward Assistant (later redesignated Nurses' Aide) in the Ministry of Health from 17th September, 1954 to 15th September, 1971, a gratuity of three thousand, one hundred and twenty-one dollars and thirteen cents and a pension with effect from 16th September, 1971, at the rate of seven hundred and forty-nine dollars and seven cents per annum; and
- (b) to Evelyn Robinson-Nottingham in respect of her service as a Temporary Ward Assistant (later redesignated Nurses' Aide) in the Ministry of Health from 1st January, 1953 to 28th June, 1969, a gratuity of two thousand, four hundred and eighty-seven dollars and thirteen cents and a pension with effect from 29th June, 1969, at the rate of five hundred and ninety-six dollars and ninety-one cents per annum.
