TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO
Act No. 25 of 1975

AN ACT to provide for the payment of a gratuity and a reduced pension to Ermine Ince, a former Cleaner, in the Ministry of Industry and Commerce.

[Assented to 4th September, 1975]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment} by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Ermine Ince (Gratuity ^{Short title} and Pension) Act, 1975.

Authority to
pay gratuity
and pension
to Ermine Ince

2. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary there shall be paid out of the Consolidated Fund to Ermine Ince, a former Cleaner in the Ministry of Industry and Commerce, in respect of her service a gratuity of five thousand, five hundred and forty-three dollars and forty-four cents and a reduced pension with effect from the 10th October, 1973, at the rate of one thousand, three hundred and thirty dollars and forty-two cents per annum.
