Act No. 22 of 1975

AN ACT to provide for Ramnarine Sukhu (deceased), former Road Officer II in the Ministry of Local Government to be regarded as if he had been duly confirmed in his post and for matters connected therewith.

[Assented to 4th September, 1975]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Ramnarine Sukhu Short title
(Confirmation of Appointment) Act, 1975.

Payment of
gratuity and
arrears of
salary

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary—

- (a) for the purposes of the payment of any gratuity to the legal personal representative of Ramnarine Sukhu, deceased, a former Road Officer II, in the Ministry of Local Government, Ramnarine Sukhu shall be regarded as if he had been confirmed in such post with effect from 15th March, 1971, and granted the increments which had accrued to him;
- (b) there shall be paid to the legal personal representative of the said Ramnarine Sukhu the difference between any salary paid to Ramnarine Sukhu and that which would have been paid to him had he been confirmed in such post with effect from 15th March, 1971 and granted the increments which had accrued to him.
