**Act No. 26 of 1975**

AN ACT to provide for the payment of superannuation benefits to Thelma Romany-Pilgrim formerly employed as a Temporary Ward Assistant in the Ministry of Health.

*[Assented to 4th September, 1975]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment  
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and  
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and  
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Thelma Romany- Short title  
Pilgrim (Gratuity and Pension) Act, 1975.

Authority to  
pay pension  
and gratuity

2. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, authority is hereby given for the payment out of the Consolidated Fund to Thelma Romany-Pilgrim in respect of her service as a Temporary Ward Assistant in the Ministry of Health during the period 21st November, 1960 to 20th August, 1972, a gratuity in the sum of two thousand, two hundred and twenty-nine dollars and fifty-six cents and a pension payable monthly and with effect from 21st August, 1972 at the rate of five hundred and thirty-five dollars and ten cents per annum.
