TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

**Act No. 12 of 1973**

[L.S.]

AN ACT to provide for the appointment of Brindsley Lezama as Estate Constable, Ministry of Agriculture, Lands and Fisheries, and for the payment of superannuation benefits to the said Brindsley Lezama.

*[Assented to 21st May, 1973]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Pensions (Brindsley Short title Lezama) Act, 1973.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary:—

- (a) Brindsley Lezama, a former daily-paid Estate Constable, Cocoa (Rehabilitation) Board, shall be deemed to have been appointed substantively to the post of Estate Constable (Range 9: Salary Scale—\$132—\$202 per month) in the Ministry of Agriculture, Lands and Fisheries with effect from the 1st day of January, 1966, and to have retired from the Public Service as such a Constable, on his attaining the age of sixty years, with effect from the 11th day of July, 1968;
- (b) there shall be paid from the Consolidated Fund to the said Brindsley Lezama a gratuity of three thousand and forty dollars and ninety-seven cents and a reduced pension with effect from the 11th day of July, 1968 at the rate of seven hundred and twenty-nine dollars and eighty-three cents per annum.

Passed in the House of Representatives this 4th day of May, 1973.
