Act No. 8 of 1974

AN ACT to authorise the computation of certain periods of service of certain employees and former employees of Governor-General's House for pension purposes.

[Assented to 16th April, 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, <sup>Enactment</sup> by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the Authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Governor-General's <sup>Short title</sup> House Employees' (Service for Pension Purposes) Act, 1974.

Periods of service to be computed for pension

Ch. 9. No. 6

Person entitled to pension precluded from receiving any other benefit

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law to the contrary the period of service at Governor-General's House (formerly called Government House) specified in the second column of the Schedule opposite the name of the employees specified in the first column of the Schedule, shall be taken into account in computing his service for pension purposes in accordance with the Pensions Ordinance, as if such period of service was public service within the meaning of the Pensions Ordinance.

3. A person who becomes entitled to pension under the provisions of this Act shall not be eligible to receive any other retirement benefits under any existing law in respect of the same period.
