Act No. 4 of 1974

AN ACT to provide for the payment of a pension and gratuity to Aubrey Jackson, formerly employed as a Temporary Health Control Officer I, in the Ministry of Health.

[Assented to 18th March, 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by **Enactment** and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Aubrey Jackson (Pen-Short title sion and Gratuity) Act, 1974.

Authority to pay
gratuity and a
reduced pension

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary relating to the grant of pensions there shall be paid out of the Consolidated Fund to Aubrey Jackson, formerly a Temporary Health Control Officer I, in the Ministry of Health, in respect of his service during the period 1st February, 1946 to 21st June, 1970, a gratuity of four thousand, five hundred and ninety-nine dollars and a reduced pension of one thousand, one hundred and three dollars and seventy cents per annum with effect from 22nd June, 1970.
