REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 40 of 1981

AN ACT to provide for the Supplementary Appropriation for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the year ending 31st December, 1981.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows—

[Assented to 23rd September, 1981]

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Short title Appropriation (No. 3) Act, 1981.

2. A further issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of three hundred and thirty-one million dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1981, under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the Schedule opposite a Head of Expenditure is hereby appropriated out of the three hundred and thirty-one million dollars for the purposes specified in relation to that Head in supplementary estimates for the year 1981.
