**Act No. 13 of 1980**

AN ACT to extend the term of office of members of the  
Tobago County Council

*[Assented to 9th April, 1980]*

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as <sup>Enactment</sup>  
follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the Tobago County Coun- <sup>Short title</sup>  
cil (Extension of term of office) Act, 1980.

Term of office  
of councillors  
extended

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any written law relating to the term of office of members of a county council, the term of office of the members of the Tobago County Council holding office on the 25th day of April, 1980 is hereby extended to the 25th day of July, 1980 or the date of the holding of the first elections to the Council established as successor to the Tobago County Council whichever first occurs.

Duration  
of Act

3. This Act shall remain in force until the 25th day of July, 1980 or the date of the holding of the elections referred to in section 2 whichever first occurs and shall then expire without prejudice to anything lawfully done by reason of the extension of the term of office.

Commencement

4. This Act shall come into operation on the 26th day of April, 1980.
