Act No. 3 of 1981

AN ACT to provide for the Supplementary Appropriation for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1981.

[Assented to 24th April, 1981]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Short title Supplementary Appropriation Act, 1981.

2. A further issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of forty-two million, seven hundred and eighteen thousand, eight hundred and nineteen dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1981, under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the Schedule opposite a Head of Expenditure is hereby appropriated out of the forty-two million, seven hundred and eighteen thousand, eight hundred and nineteen dollars for the purposes specified in relation to that Head in Supplementary Estimates for 1981.
