Act No. 12 of 1978

AN ACT to provide for the appointment of Sydney Smith as Clerk I, Ministry of Agriculture, Lands and Fisheries and for the payment of superannuation benefits to the said Sydney Smith.

[Assented to 18th April, 1978]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Sydney Smith (Pension Short title and Gratuity) Act, 1978.

Interpretation

2. In this Act "the former Act" means the Sydney Smith (Pension and Gratuity) Act, 1975.

Authority to pay gratuity and reduced pension to Sydney Smith

3. (1) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary there shall be paid from the Consolidated Fund to Sydney Smith who shall be deemed to be appointed Clerk I in the Ministry of Agriculture, Lands and Fisheries with effect from 26th April, 1966, a gratuity of three thousand and seventy-two dollars and a reduced pension payable monthly at the rate of seven hundred and thirty-seven dollars and twenty-eight cents per annum with effect from 20th May, 1970, the date on which he attained the compulsory retirement age of sixty years.

(2) Any sums paid under the former Act to Sydney Smith by way of gratuity and pension shall be set off against any sums which he is entitled to be paid under subsection (1).

Repeal

4. The former Act is repealed.
