**AN ACT to incorporate the John Hayes Memorial Kidney
Foundation of Trinidad and Tobago.**

[Assented to 12th October, 1979]

WHEREAS there has been established in Trinidad and Preamble
Tobago an association known as the John Hayes
Memorial Kidney Foundation.

And whereas it is expedient that the John Hayes Memorial Kidney Foundation should be incorporated for the purpose of exercising the powers set out below.

Enactment

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows:—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as The John Hayes Memorial Kidney Foundation (Incorporation) Act, 1979.

Incorporation of the Foundation

2. The John Hayes Memorial Kidney Foundation (hereinafter referred to as "The Foundation") is hereby enacted a body corporate.

Aims and Objects to

3. The aims and objects of the Foundation are to:

- (a) encourage and aid medically and scientifically approved efforts for the prevention investigation and treatment of kidney disease;
- (b) provide and purchase equipment, drugs, apparatus and all such provisions and requirements as may be necessary for the prevention investigation and treatment of kidney disease;
- (c) make donations to hospitals and or other approved medical and scientific institutions involved with the prevention investigation and or treatment of kidney disease;
- (d) promote and help the rehabilitation of kidney patients and to assist in the promotion and helping of the same;
- (e) write, print, publish, issue and circulate gratuitously or otherwise any reports or periodicals, books, pamphlets, leaflets or other documents to increase public awareness of matters relating to the kidney;
- (f) arrange and provide for or join in arranging and providing for the holding of exhibitions, meetings, lectures and classes, on matters relating to the kidney;

- (g) promote, encourage and undertake or organise research and experimental work on matters relating to the kidney.

4. (1) The foundation shall have the powers herein- Powers of the
after set forth in this section and such other powers as Foundation
are appropriate to its aims and objects as are from time
to time specified in its rules.

(2) The Foundation shall have power:

- (a) to purchase or otherwise acquire land or any estate or interest in land;
- (b) to accept subscriptions and donations (whether of real or personal estate) and devises and bequests for all or any of the objects aforesaid and to sell and dispose of, to lease and accept surrenders of leases and manage all real estate (including leaseholds) so received and not required to be or capable of being occupied for the purposes of the Foundation and generally to manage, invest and expand all moneys belonging to the Foundation;
- (c) to obtain, collect and receive money and funds by way of contributions, donations, legacies, grants and any other lawful method, and accept and receive gifts of property of any description (whether subject to any special trusts or not);
- (d) to support, contribute to or work in association with any other charitable body or bodies which may have or be working towards the achievement of similar objectives.

shall sign every such document and such signing shall be *prima facie* evidence that the said seal was duly affixed and that the same is the lawful seal of the Foundation.

Service of
Documents on
Foundation

7. (1) The Foundation shall at all times have a fixed address for service of documents on the Foundation and that address and any changes thereof shall be registered with the Registrar General within twenty-eight days of the date of incorporation or the change of address as the case may be.

(2) All documents to be served on the Foundation may be served by leaving the same at or by sending the same by Registered Post to the registered address of the Foundation.

(3) Failure to register the address and any change thereof is a summary offence and renders the Foundation liable to a fine of one hundred and twenty dollars and to a further fine of ten dollars for each day during which the offence continues after conviction therefor.

Power to
make Rules

8. The Foundation may make rules for the proper conduct of its proceedings and the discharge of its powers and functions and may vary or revoke such rules.

Saving of State
or other rights

9. Nothing in this Act shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of the State or of any bodies politic or corporate or of any other persons except such as are mentioned or referred to in this Act and those claiming by, through, from or under them.
