**AN ACT to incorporate The Trinidad and Tobago Netball
Association.**

[Assented to 8th August, 1979]

WHEREAS for many years there has been in existence Preamble
**and functioning an Association known as The Trinidad
and Tobago Netball Association.**

And whereas it is expedient that the Association be incorporated for the purposes set out below.

Enactment	ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows:—
Short title	1. This Act may be cited as The Trinidad and Tobago Netball Association (Incorporation) Act, 1979.
Incorporation	2. The Trinidad and Tobago Netball Association (hereinafter referred to as "the Association") is hereby created a body corporate.
Purposes of Association	3. The purpose of the Association is to foster, regulate and control the sport of Netball (under the International Federation of Netball Associations System) and to promote friendly tournaments at national and international level.
Mode of execution of documents	4. The affairs of the Association shall be managed by a Council whose election powers and procedures shall be as prescribed in the Constitution and Rules of the Association.
Service of documents on Association	5. All documents requiring the seal of the Association shall be sealed with the common seal in the presence of its President and Secretary who shall sign every such document and such signing shall be <i>prima facie</i> evidence that the said seal was duly affixed and that the same is the lawful seal of the Association.
	6. (1) The Association shall at all times have a fixed address in Trinidad and Tobago for the service of documents on it and this address shall be registered with the Registrar General.
	(2) Every document to be served on the Association may be served by leaving it at, or by sending it by registered post to the registered address of the Association.
	(3) Failure to register the address and any change thereof is a summary offence and renders the Association liable on summary conviction to a fine of one hundred and twenty dollars and to a further fine of ten dollars for each day during which the offence continues after conviction therefor.

7. The Association may make rules for the proper ^{Power to} conduct of its proceedings and discharge of its functions ^{make rules} and powers and may vary or revoke such rules.

8. Nothing in this Act shall affect or be deemed to ^{Saving of State} affect the rights of the State, or of any bodies politic or ^{or other rights} corporate or of any persons, except such as are mentioned or referred to in this Act and those claiming by, through, from or under them.
