REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

**Act No. 22 of 1992**

AN ACT to provide for the Service of Trinidad and  
Tobago for the year ending on the 31st day of  
December, 1993.

*[Assented to 4th December, 1992]*

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment  
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, Short title  
1993.

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of eight thousand and fifty-four million, six hundred and seventy-seven thousand, three hundred and seventy-one dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1993 under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the Schedule opposite to a Head is hereby appropriated out of the said sum of eight thousand and fifty-four million, six hundred and seventy-seven thousand, three hundred and seventy-one dollars for the purpose specified in relation to that Head in the Estimates for the said year.

Commencement

3. This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1993.
