**AN ACT for the incorporation of the Amarjyoth Sabha
and matters incidental thereto**

[Assented to 12th March, 1993]

WHEREAS there has been established in Trinidad and
Tobago, an Organisation known as the Amarjyoth
Sabha:

And whereas it is expedient that the Amarjyoth Sabha be incorporated for the purposes hereinafter set forth:

| Enactment | ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows:— |
| Short title | 1. This Act may be cited as the Amarjyoth Sabha (Incorporation) Act, 1993. |
| Incorporation | 2. The Amarjyoth Sabha (hereinafter called “The Organisation”) is hereby created a body corporate. |
| Aims and objects | 3. The aims and objects of the Organisation are— <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) to promote the ideals of the Hindu Dharma amongst the public at large; (b) to promote and encourage religious, cultural, educational and social activities so as to improve knowledge, strengthen faith, improve discipline and generate peace, love and unity among the youths and the public at large; (c) to give assistance to the needy and to render humanitarian services; (d) to develop concern for the environment; (e) to promote the involvement in the community by all citizens; (f) to instill knowledge of national pride and freedom that will motivate and enable followers to contribute with others to the building of a just, humane and participatory society; (g) to give support to other organisations with similar aims and objects; and (h) to do all such other things as are necessary, incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above aims and objects. |
| Powers of the Organisation | 4. The Organisation shall have power— <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) to acquire by purchase, transfer, donation, exchange, devise, bequest, grant, gift, conveyance or howsoever otherwise, any |

real or personal property or any estate or interest therein;

- (b) to accept surrenders or reconveyances and to enter into contracts; and
- (c) to sell, exchange, demise, mortgage or otherwise dispose of and deal with all property which may for the time being be vested in it, subject to any restraint, reservation or condition contained in the document under which it has acquired title thereto.

5. All real or personal property of whatever nature now held by or vested in any person for the use and benefit of the Organisation, is hereby transferred to and vested in the Organisation.

Transfer and
vesting of
Property

6. All documents requiring the seal of the Organisation shall be sealed with the common seal of the Organisation in the presence of the President and Secretary for the time being in office or in the event of incapacity in the presence of some other person or persons authorised for that purpose by the Organisation who shall both sign every such document and such signing shall be *prima facie* evidence that the said seal was duly affixed and that the same is the lawful seal of the Organisation.

Mode of execution
of documents

7. (1) The Organisation shall at all times have a fixed address in Trinidad and Tobago for the service of documents on the Organisation and that address and any change thereof shall be registered with the Registrar General within twenty-eight days of the date of incorporation or the change of address as the case may be.

Service of
documents

(2) Every document to be served on the Organisation may be served by leaving the same at or

by sending the same by registered post to the registered address of the Organisation.

(3) Failure to register the address and any change thereof is a summary offence and renders the Organisation liable to a fine of one hundred and twenty dollars and to a further fine of ten dollars for each day during which the offence continues after conviction therefor.

Power to make
rules

8. The Organisation may from time to time make rules for the proper conduct of its proceedings and discharge of its duties, powers and functions and may amend such rules.

Saving of State and
other rights

9. Nothing in this Act shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of the State, or of any bodies politic or corporate or of any persons, except such as are mentioned or referred to in this Act and those claiming by, through, from or under them.
