Act No. 1 of 1992

AN ACT to provide for the service of Trinidad and Tobago
for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1992.

[Assented to 30th January, 1992]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as **Enactment**
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 1992. **Short title**

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of seven thousand, six hundred and forty-two million, one hundred and seventy-nine thousand, five hundred and ninety-eight dollars is hereby authorized for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1992 under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule and the sum specified in the Schedule opposite to a Head is hereby appropriated out of the said sum of seven thousand six hundred and forty-two million, one hundred and seventy-nine thousand, five hundred and ninety-eight dollars for the purpose specified in relation to that Head in the Estimates for the said year.

Commencement

3. This Act is deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1992.
